NON-RESIDENTIAL STUDENTS

A. HISTORY

Zomba Theological College was opened in 1977 to train Church Ministers of the Church of Central Africa Presbyterian, which includes the Synods of Blantyre, Livingstonia, Nkhoma, Harare and Zambia. The College also trains ministers for the other denominations, such as Churches of Christ, Anglican, Methodist and Baptist. Recently Zomba Theological College has opened its doors to Non-Residential Students who wish to study theology full-time and are conversant with the Presbyterian tradition of the College. These students are trained not to become ordained ministers; but those who feel called to the ordained ministry are requested to apply through their churches.

B. COURSES

1. **Diploma in Theology**

The entrance requirements are **six (6) credits at MSCE**; one (1) of the credits must be English. Subjects offered are as follows (please see Diploma prospectus for explanation of courses):

2. **Bachelor of Divinity**

The degree program is a two-year course. Entrance into this program is dependent on a student gaining an average of 55 % or more in the first and second years of the Diploma in Theology.

Alternatively, if a student has previously gained the Diploma in Theology with an average of 55 % or above, then the student can enter immediately into the degree course. Please note that here also **six (6) credits at MSCE** is a must for entry into Bachelor of Divinity. Subjects offered are as follows (please see Degree prospectus for explanation of courses):

C. TUITION FEES

The Tuition Fees for the 2009 academic year amount to **MK 80 000.00**, which are payable in three installments (*at the beginning of each term*, i.e. MK30000 **Term 1**; MK25000 **Term 2**; and MK25000 **Term 3**). Payment is through our Bank Account and the student is asked to bring **Deposit Slip** to the College Treasurer's or Dean of Studies' Office (*see below for details of our Bank Account*). Please note that Tuition Fees do not include textbooks; students are expected to buy their own textbooks. Also note that the College does not offer accommodation; hence, non-residential students will have to find their own accommodation.

D. APPLICATION FEE & APPLICATION FORMS

Application Fee is **MK500** and is **non-refundable**. Students wishing to apply are advised to deposit this amount into our Bank Account before submitting the Application Forms into the Office of the Dean of Studies or the Principal's Secretary. Payment of application fee and submission of application forms **does not** mean that you have been accepted.
